EUROPEAN CREDIT TRANSFER SYSTEM

In the French higher education system, each course unit is graded on a scale from 0 to 20 points. 0 being the worst grade, 20 the best. The minimum passing grade is 12. The ECTS system is used at RUBIKA. The transcript of records provided by the department will indicate the ECTS scale for each French grade awarded in order to facilitate the credit transfer.
